





## Delta Airlines Bringing First Class Seating to Lafayette Regional Airport in June!

Beginning June 8, summer travelers looking to fly first class to Atlanta from Lafayette will have that option. Delta Airlines has announced that they will offer two flights a day on CRJ700 Regional Jets each of which has nine first class seats. The addition of the larger jets increases the daily number of seats available to Atlanta to 330 per day, 30 more than the current 300. This service will be available seven days a week.

"We're bringing in the larger jets to handle the anticipated uptick in passengers for summer travel," says Delta Station Manager Jason Saucier. "The CRJ700s will be used for the first two flights of the day – at 6:05 a.m. and 7:20 a.m. The planes will return to Lafayette for 8:30 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. flights."

Saucier says plans are for the CRJ700s to be used until August 7, and then revert back to the 50-seat CRJ200 currently being used. Saucier adds the airline generally upgrades coach passengers who are members of the airline's frequent flier program to unsold first class seats based on the amount of miles they have accumulated.

Lafayette Regional Airport Director of Aviation Greg Roberts is hopeful the new service will be well received by the travelers of Acadiana. "I think if Delta sees that the Lafayette travelers can support a jet that has first class seats, they might decide to make the addition of the CRJ700s a permanent move. I know our frequent fliers will enjoy the change." (F&S)

Milton stated Ujamma 2012 is focused on interconnecting the Black community in Lafayette, and Black communities across the state.

"We want to educate and elevate our people ... . I am unaware of any African-centered schools and programs in Lafayette. We want to reconnect the Black value system ... because many Black people are not aware of the full nature of our struggles. We have bought into capitalism, materialism, sexism and even notions of supremacy, he said."

"Yes, we have a Black president ... and Blacks who have made achievements in America. But we still have a long way to go! Some African-centered warriors have worked so hard to save all of our people and lost themselves. Ujamma 2012 wants to connect pockets of like mind African Americans, and anyone else, to fight against oppressors who want to eliminate affirmative action, suppress voting rights and otherwise reverse the gains fought for and won by the generation before us ...," he said.
